Robert Schlaefer, Glacial Drumlin School received \$1,000 to construct and maintain a native planting area, "Hawks Field," at Glacial Drumlin.


John Hagen, Sheryl Barak, and **Nancy Casto**, Cottage Grove Elementary, received \$600 to pay for access to pilot the Online Math Practice Website IXL.Com. The site enables students to practice their math skills at their own pace.

Rebecca Fox-Blair, Ian Lowe and **Adam McCormick** of MG21, were granted \$1,000 to implement a student leadership program at the school.

After the grant presentations, guests moved into the auditorium to honor **Lori Nahirniak**. In her years at MG, Lori's choirs, musicals and show choirs have developed a reputation for excellence. Speakers **Lauren Homburg** (Class of 2007), **Eric Guenthner** (Class of 2011) and former choir parent Mary O'Connor reminisced about their experiences with Lori in the MG choir program. They were followed by a performance by this year's "Silver Connection", MG's award-winning show choir. The evening wrapped up with a special arrangement being sung to Lori by the Senior women. Funds raised at the event will be detailed in the Spring 2016 issue of Traditions and used for MGEF teacher grants and to purchase musical instruments for the MG Choir Department.

MG Mourns Dick Rundle

The Monona Grove community recently lost another legendary coach with the death of **Richard "Dick" Rundle** at age 80, on October 22, 2015. Rundle coached football at Monona Grove High School from 1956-1989; serving as head coach from 1962-89. He retired with an overall record of 165-50-3 which included 15 conference championships, two state championships and four undefeated seasons. In addition, he became one of a handful of Wisconsin coaches to win a state championship in more than one sport when his MG golf team won the state golf championship in 1987. Coach Rundle had one of the highest winning percentages in the United States, losing only 30 football games in 25 years. During that period of time his teams never finished below 1st or 2nd place.

The National High School Coaches Association named Rundle to its Hall of Fame in 2003. He also was a member of the Luther College Hall of Fame, served on the National High School Coaches Association Board of Directors, and for decades served as executive director of the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association. Services were held for Coach Rundle on October 27, 2015 at Immaculate Heart of Mary Church in Monona. MGEF would like to thank those alumni and staff who have made memorial donations to the Education Foundation in Coach Rundle's name.

Brost Named Wisconsin High School Principal of the Year



Monona Grove High School Principal Paul Brost was recently named Wisconsin's High School Principal of the Year by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction and the Association of Wisconsin School Administrators. Brost was selected for his relationship building skills and initiatives both in and outside the classroom. In a news release, State Schools

Superintendent Tony Evers cited him as "a model educational leader who is in the forefront for creating a welcoming and safe school environment, focusing on student academic achievement and using data to improve staff and student outcomes -- critical initiatives that improve our schools and make a difference for children." Brost has served as principal at MG since 2004. He earned a bachelor's degree from Mankato State University and master's and doctoral degrees from UW-Madison.
