The Monona Grove Silver Eagles completed a perfect 14-0 season by winning the third State Football Championship in school history on November 22, 2013. They came from behind to win a thrilling 21-17 victory over Greendale at Camp Randall Stadium.

On November 26, the Packers and the Wisconsin Football Coaches Association (WFCA), named Coach **Mike Stassi** ('79) Wisconsin's High School Coach of the Year. Stassi, a running back who led the Silver Eagles to the 1977 State Championships, later played running back, defensive back and wide receiver for the Wisconsin Badgers under coach Dave McClain.
