MG Boys Swim Team makes it Four in a Row!

The Monona Grove Boys Swim Team won their fourth consecutive Division 2 state championship and fifth overall with a score of 333 points on February 15 at the University of Wisconsin Natatorium. Along the way, senior **Ben McDade**, a University of Indiana recruit, set a medal record, earning his 15th career state title and putting his name in WIAA history books as the swimmer with the most championship medals, counting relay and individual events. He is now also the only swimmer in WIAA history to win four state titles in two individual events — the 200 and 500 freestyles. **McDade** and his teammates including fellow seniors **Jacob Lippiatt**, **Shane Sackett**, **Bronz Geissler** and **Eric Storms** and junior **Josh**

Brandt Donation Funds Student Career Exploration

In December, 2017, MGHS Associate Principal Kris Langer, and Career and Technical Education Coordinator Jennifer Macias, presented a proposal to the Monona Grove Education Foundation Board for the use of the Albert E. Brandt Memorial Fund. The Brandt family envisioned this fund being used to create a program for Monona Grove students to prepare them academically to explore all career options suited to their abilities and assist in developing meaningful and achievable life time goals. Monona Grove High School plans to use some of the funds to sponsor trips for groups of students to explore different post-graduation career and education options. By getting them on campus for a real-time experience of what life could be like academically after high school, students are able to more easily visualize themselves in these scenarios. This then increases their motivation to pursue further education after high school.

In the spring of 2018, two trips to Madison College were planned to allow students to explore the following areas: Applied Science, Engineering and Technology, Health Education, Arts and Science, Human and Protective Services and Business. The visits included a 30 minute overview presentation, a one hour major specific tour, and a 30 minute review of the application process and prerequisites for applying to Madison College. For the 2018-2019 school year, the plan is to expand the trips to include state schools, technical schools, cosmetology schools and other specialty schools to appeal to a variety of different students on different paths.

Langer and Macias are looking forward to exposing MGHS students to the opportunities that exist for them!


