Anonymous Donation Funds Band and Auditorium Improvements

This spring MGEF received an anonymous \$10,000 donation intended to be used for the purchase of instruments and equipment for the MGHS Band and upgrades and equipment for the Ed Schwan Auditorium at the high school. Each designee received \$5,000. Tight school building budgets have hampered the ability to keep up with the necessary replacements of equipment and improvements needed to maintain high quality programs and experiences for our students. Cara Collins, High School Band Director and Matthew Bittorf, Auditorium Director quickly put the funds to use Collins identified the need to replace a vibraphone that was in poor playing condition and a bass clarinet in need of constant repair. She says "Our previous vibraphone was purchased a very long time ago and was falling apart. The band students are so excited to use this new piece of percussion equipment and have been treating it like a new sibling!" Other bass clarinets owned by the school district were purchased in the 1950's and 1970's and she reports that it is being played by a sophomore band student "who is ecstatic to have a working instrument".

Bittorf, who became Auditorium Director last year, found need for many replacements or improvements. He noted that there were many small but important pieces of equipment that needed upgrades. The funds were used to replace and upgrade audio equipment including wireless microphones and improved speakers, accessories for the LED stage lighting and tools for the auditorium shop. He tells us, "I can't say this enough, I am very grateful for this contribution. There are still plenty of items still left on my spending list and I would let anyone know that any monetary donations to the auditorium would immediately go towards "shovel ready" projects that would benefit our students and community."

The Monona Grove Education Foundation thanks the anonymous donor for their thoughtful and caring contribution to the School District and encourages others to follow their generous example.


