# **Monona Grove Schools Respond to Covid-19**

These are disorienting and difficult times for many of us, but schools have the opportunity to have a grounding effect for our students and families. In the cascade of canceled concerts, field trips, and milestones like prom and graduation during the spring of 2020, students and families were met with support of social emotional wellness as well as virtual at-home learning.

Like many schools across the state and nation, the teachers and staff at Monona Grove responded swiftly to the Covid-19 crisis. After organizing pick up of tablets and laptops, our staff provided thousands of free meals to the community, thousands of virtual, grade-level lessons for 4K-12, implemented virtual support and resources to families, organized food and supply drives for the community, scheduled countless video meetings with students, and more. "Our intention was for families to know they were not in this alone, and that we would continue to serve them in every way we could," said Superintendent Dan Olson. "I'm incredibly proud of our staff, families, and community for coming together and supporting each other."

Virtual /at-home learning: Participation and engagement in tasks assigned by teachers was expected. Students showed 'proof of learning' through their work product, not how many hours or minutes they sat in front of their device. Teachers and principals worked together with families to problem-solve any barriers.

Graduation: Our seniors and their families have worked incredibly hard and have looked forward to graduation for a long time. It is a major milestone, and one that we are used to sharing with extended family and friends. Public Health has said that graduation parades or drive-through graduations constitute a mass gathering and are in violation of their orders. Because of these orders and local guidance, this year's MGHS and MG21 graduation ceremonies were virtual. Students, teachers, and school administrators planned these virtual graduations as an opportunity to celebrate and worked hard to make it meaningful for students and families. Both MG21 and MGHS graduation ceremonies are available on the Monona Community Media YouTube channel.
