Pay it Forward Initiative

In March the MGEF and the Optimists Club of Cottage Grove joined forces to begin expanding the Weekend Snack Pack Program to students in Monona as part of our Pay It Forward Initiative. Originally the Optimists were limited to helping only Cottage Grove resident students. The program has added approximately 60 students in Monona and will meet their needs for the remainder of the 2020-21 school year. The program will continue for the 2021-22 school year, serving approximately 200 students each week. It is a significant undertaking to purchase, store, bag, and distribute the meals to the schools each week.

In addition to the Weekend Snack Pack Program, Pay It Forward has distributed funds to MGSD for headphones and water bottles for student use during the school day. I would like to thank the class of 1981 for the love, care and friendship shared with my brother, **Derald "Rusty" Smedegard**, over the last 52 years. After recuperating from a heart attack, Rusty lost the battle and the Lord took him home at age 57.

While he was in the hospital, several of you requested to be on a text link to receive updates. Many of you posted his progress on Facebook requesting prayers for his full recovery.

You see my brother was officially diagnosed with autism at the age of 55, but we all knew he was uniquely special all along. While having a sibling with autism brings challenges, it also brings extraordinary and indescribable joys. It took some of us time to mature and realize his amazing attributes. Although 9 years separate my class from the class of '81, I have had the pleasure of getting to know several of you through the years, for which I am grateful.

Roughly 5 years ago, a group of you pitched in funds to get him a smartphone and data plan. He never did take to the new technology, but he understood the magnitude of what you'd done for him. The list of what has

been done through the years for Rusty would exceed this note, but I know the short list: surprise birthday parties, BBQ's, Sheepshead games, Brewers games, help moving, haircuts and this is one of the many reasons why I am appreciative for your class (& other MG friends)

Rusty stated several times that the best day of his life was *Senior Rec Day*. He was presented with an award for "Best Sports Caster". Rusty, then, gave a speech which ignited a 5-minute standing ovation. *Most memorable* was another award Rusty was given at the 20-year class reunion which Rusty was very proud of. No wonder he loved class reunions so much.

I asked Rusty's friend and classmate why and how his class was so amazing. The answer was, "because of Rusty". "Any class with Rusty in it would've been the same". He continued by stating Rusty had gotten picked on but didn't hold grudges. He instead forgave and offered mercy as he lived by the golden rule. Rusty found the way to earn people's respect by turning the other cheek.

Rusty had a co-worker, who bullied him for years. When the co-worker hurt his back, Rusty sent him 50 dollars. He was asked why you would give him money, his reply was "he needed it more than I did".

We learned countless life lessons from you, Rusty and we miss you dearly!
