Third Annual Great Golf Ball Drop – October 8, 2022!!

Take cover! It will be raining golf balls on Saturday, October 8, 2022, as the third annual Great Golf Ball Drop takes to the skies to raise money for the Monona Grove Education Foundation (MGEF) and its annual education initiatives. In this fun twist on a traditional raffle, the MGEF partners with the Monona Volunteer Fire Department to drop 500 golf balls from a ladder truck. The 19 balls closest, and the one ball furthest, to the hole win cash prizes.

All funds will benefit the Pay It Forward program and Monona Grove Education Foundation Teacher **Innovation Grants.**

The Pay It Forward program was designed to provide extra support and financial assistance to Monona Grove students struggling with food stability or clothing; and those needing additional educational support outside of traditional school programs. Now in its third year, the Pay It Forward program has helped fund a wide range of initiatives including support of the Optimists Club Snack Pack Program; the purchase of quality ear buds to support students with virtual learning; and support of the district's student services clothing reserves so they could purchase important clothing items for students.

The MGEF Innovation Grants support efforts to bring innovative new ideas and programs into the district that fall outside of traditional funding. The Foundation holds an open application period each year in which teachers and other school personnel are encouraged to submit unique ideas for consideration. Since 2010, the MGEF has supported 75 different innovation grants worth more than \$93,000.

"The Great Golf Ball Drop is tremendously important for the Foundation and our education community," said MGEF President Jason McCutchin. "It's an important vehicle for funding both the Pay It Forward Program and the annual Innovation Grants, and it helps us spread awareness about the important work that we do at the Foundation. Plus, who doesn't want a chance to win \$1,000?"

MGEF Receives Bequest from Estate of Mary Jean Hlavac



MGEF has received a very generous bequest of over \$375,000 from the estate of former Nichols Elementary teacher Mary Jean Hlavac who passed away in February, 2021. Her husband Frank (Lud) Hlavac, who passed away in

2015, was Monona Grove's first basketball coach and taught industrial arts at the high school. The Hlavacs retired from teaching in 1978 to devote full time to developing their Angus beef cattle business in the Town of Cottage Grove. For the next 30 years, they built an award-winning herd including many champions and traveled all over the U.S. visiting Angus cattle ranches and attending shows.

20% of the Hlavac bequest is to be given to the MGHS Athletic Department. The remaining monies are to be used to establish an endowment to fund future scholarships. Projected earnings of 5% annually would give MGEF the ability to award about \$15,000 in scholarships each year. The scholarships are intended for worthy students who played basketball at MGHS.
